In my role at the Canadian Space Agency, I provide the Agency and Canada's Chief Science Advisor with a scientist's perspective on space activities.



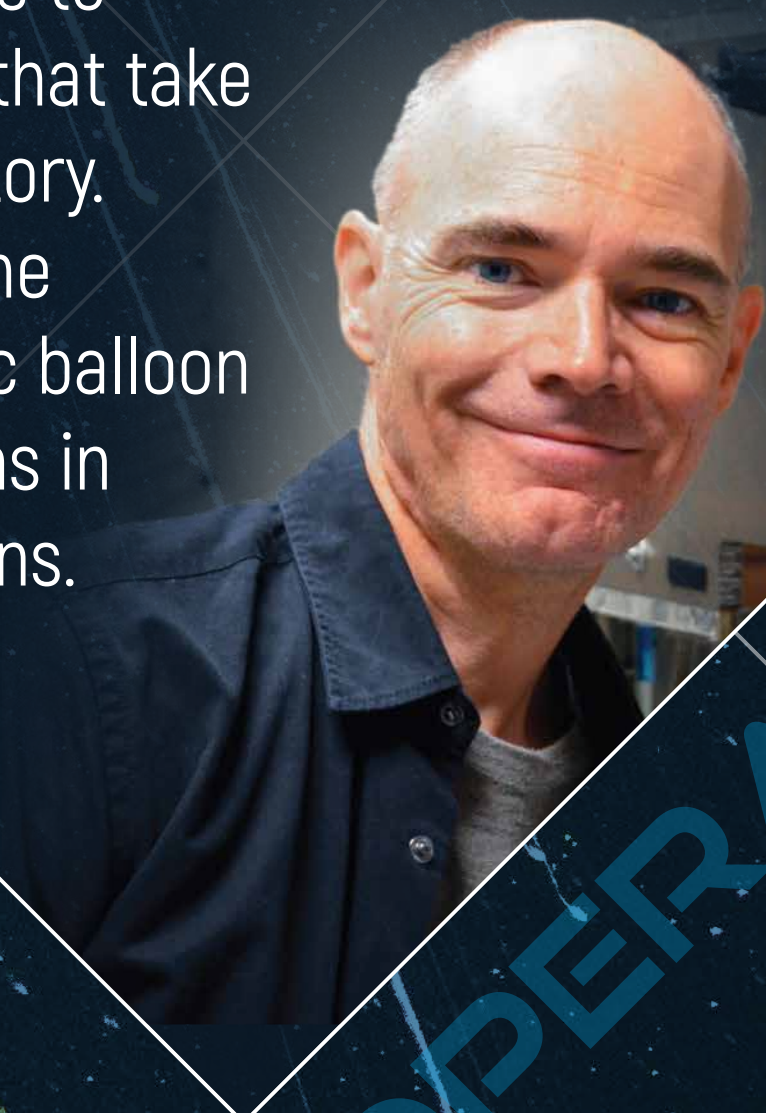
